


agent for Music Theatre International (NY)

Needless to say I have been a tad busy. We are only 10 off last June's total. Our next busy time is the Entertainers' Festival.



GOLDEN GIRLS NEWS

olden Girls' Director and performer extraordinaire, Pauline Davies, has hung up her Director's hat and packed away her dancing shoes and vocal chords.

Pauline's contribution to the Spotlight Golden Girls is so immense it cannot be measured. She has managed, directed, and performed with the group for the last twenty years. Not only has she danced, sung, mimed and impersonated with a vitality unsurpassed, but she has also organised the program for each show, planned rehearsals, choreographed numbers, co-ordinated costumes, and solved all the problems directors are required to solve, and all this with a smile.

Pauline recalls some of her time with Spotlight and the Golden Girls:

I joined Spotlight the first week in October 1958. During the following years I took part in revues, musicals and other productions. My first was a revue in 1959 called Fine and Dandy. Marilyn Hodge was a co-director for that show and we are fortunate that Marilyn is going to be the next director for the Golden Girls. Indeed Marilyn has been my hard-working assistant for many years. The revue days were wonderful as were the early days of the musicals.

In my time at Spotlight I have been Secretary, Librarian, Council Member, Publicity Officer, Assistant to the Director, and Wardrobe Mistress. I also worked behind the scenes if I was not performing on stage for a production. I enjoyed it all. It was in September 1990, that Isobel Williams and I decided to gather together an active group of eight to ten mature ladies to present a variety show at nursing homes, senior citizens' clubs and retirement villages. These shows were along the lines of our early revues minus the props and scenery. The group rehearsed and performed regularly and became known as the Spotlight Golden Girls.

Mγ years, spent entertaining with the Golden Girls, have given me such a lot of pleasure. Although we often had performance difficult areas, very small and quite inadequate change rooms (often store rooms) the show always went on. We all worked so well together, and gave each other support when needed, and yes, we had lots of laughs.

I will miss being a Golden Girl very much; fortunately friendships can always continue.

My thanks go to all the "Girls" and the supporters I have worked with throughout the last twenty years. I wish everyone many more years of happy entertaining bringing joy to so many.

As I am a Life Member of Spotlight, I am only retiring from being an active member of the Golden Girls and not retiring from Spotlight Theatre Company which I love so much.

All who have worked with Pauline have benefited from her knowledge, generosity, and thoughtfulness. We are fortunate to know Pauline and to be able to call her friend. We wish her all the best in her retirement.


