

*Motormouth Maybelle* (f, alto, supporting): Seaweed's and Little Inez's mother.


*Little Inez* (f, soprano, featured): Seaweed's little sister, who wants to be on the Corny Collins Show.

Peter, Jess and Terri have all been busy, and Martina has started on the vocals for the High School Musical theatre.


