
Nomination for Life Membership according to Constitution:

The bar will be open for drinks and if you wish to stay after the meeting for a drink, tea or coffee and a chat, a small plate of supper would be appreciated.



YOUTH ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT JUNE 2018.


Saturday mornings are certainly fun but it is also very cold, especially for the 9.00am and 10.30am classes, so we decided to introduce a "Hoodie" as an optional purchase. We sent around several emails regarding these jackets and also a size chart. Unfortunately there had to be a cut-off date and we received 32 orders for the jackets.

They are black with the reduced size Spotlight logo printed on the left hand side of the front of the jacket. Providing all goes well with the print we should get them back into the Costume Hire shop by the commencement of Term 3. It would greatly help with the accounting if the parents could pay into the Spotlight Theatre Bank account, as they do their fees, making a reference of surname of the student and class; the price is \$32.00. *Please note that the class time is really important as we have over 100 Intermediate and Junior students and it makes it so much easier for Kay and I.* This is not just for the jackets but for the term fees also.

At the beginning of next term Terri will announce the Junior play and work will begin on that. Hannah's Intermediate play **Robin Hood** is coming together really well and the students have been very busy learning their lines. Parents can really help at this time of the year when we are planning our shows, by listening to their children's lines. It gives them so much more confidence if they know their lines off by heart, rather than reading from the script.

The Senior Drama play The Comedy of Errors by William Shakespeare, has been moved forward one week to the 31st August and 1st September. Notices about the rehearsal days will be emailed shortly. Many of the senior students attended the play *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night Time* in Brisbane. Matt Pearson, Terri and Hannah all accompanied these students to the theatre and back again and a good time was had by all.

The Music Theatre classes have been rehearsing together for the last two weeks as their *Showcase* production is almost here. **Thursday the 28th is the opening night and it will continue on the 29th and 30th of July**. Hannah and Matt are doing an amazing job, melding four Music Theatre classes into one production; this requires a lot of skill as we have over 90 students taking part. It is wonderful to see the students all come together with great respect for each other's ability; I think everyone is having a lot of fun. Tickets are available from the Costume Hire shop; don't leave it until the day because you may be disappointed as we only have so many tickets for each night.

MICHELLE BRINGS HOPE TO BALI CHILDREN

On 26th May 2018 I embarked on an 84km Ultra marathon journey through the night in Bali from North to South to raise money for the community of Tigawasa in the North of Bali where families live on \$2 per day. Along with 13 other runners we started our journey 6.40pm Saturday night and collectively to date have raise over \$80K (myself personally over \$5500) that will ensure 80 children will receive a 6 year primary school scholarship that they would normally not be able to afford.

The night was hot starting around 30 degrees and humid and involved over 15km of hill climbing from 4-20 ish km mark. There were 3

travelling support vehicles offering nutrition and medical supplies. We all travelled our own pace which meant much of the run was alone and on the dark roads of Bali running through small villages of potholes, hills and lots of barking dogs. I got lost in the rice paddies for too long and suffered some pain in my left leg that was eliminated when I knew there was only 13km left to run.

I ended up coming in 3rd person and 1st female in approx 11 hours and 25 minutes as the sun was rising at Canguu just near the beach. It was a most amazing run and week of discovery personal limits, boundaries with a bunch of other crazy people who have impacted my life profoundly over the week of organisation. Meeting the kids and finding more about the charities in Bali that work tirelessly for these communities – Classroom of Hope and Bali Childrens' Foundation.
