

We are now three weeks into the new term and many changes have been made for the New Year.

Three new teachers have joined our professional team and work has already begun on the year's programme

In Senior Drama we have two new very qualified teachers, Shelley Grace, Head Teacher Senior Drama and Taylor Holmes, Assistant Teacher Senior Drama and Assistant Teacher for Intermediate Drama Hannah Crowther remains as Head Teacher of Intermediate Drama. Kirstie Sleeman is Head of our Junior Drama Department. Class numbers have increased and there are very few spaces left. We divided the Monday classes into two separate classes making the first class a little later to enable students to get to Spotlight from school. If you are interested in these classes please call me and we will discuss a place in either class.

Matt Pearson and Hannah Crowther once again head up the Music Theatre classes and these have grown beyond all expectation. We now have 100 students in Music Theatre which will obviously alter our end of year programme to accommodate everyone. The enthusiasm of these two teachers is infectious and I get many emails telling me what a great time the students are having.

It was Matt and Hannah's idea to have a Young Adult class once again at Spotlight as the timing was right. This was a class that was held a few years ago but the students left and went to Drama schools and University and it did not work to have a class with few students. However, we now have 13 registered students, and we are receiving a couple of enquiries about the class each week. If you think you would like to do this class, you need to be over 18 years of age, please give me a call.

Our Intermediate Drama classes are quite full and many of the students in these classes took advantage of our offer to do Intermediate Music Theatre on Wednesday along with their chosen class on Saturday. It is a good price for students who really would like to do both and great preparation for the students moving to Senior classes next year.

Our Junior Drama classes have commenced with Hannah and Kirstie and the students are having fun, which is what this class is all about.

I thank everyone for their good wishes sent to me and I am pleased to say I will be up and around in the next four weeks. Kay has been wonderful coming around the house and working with me on the computer and I thank all parents who responded to our emails and invoices regarding payment of fees.

In closing I would ask all parents to please reference each communication, payments or emails, with their students surname and class, i.e. DALTON MT TUES. This will help Kay and I identify who it is and save so much time looking through 250+ students.



This will be a group audition. Please note that you must attend the dance call. Please wear appropriate footwear. No bare feet will be allowed.

FROM 12:00 VOCAL AUDITIONS

The vocal auditions will be held in small groups at 30-minute intervals. You will need to prepare a 90 second piece in a musical theatre style that best demonstrates your vocal ability. You will need to provide a backing (CD, AUX or USB), as no repetiteur will be available.

CALLBACKS WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY 14TH MARCH 2019 AT SPOTLIGHT THEATRE.

Please note that if successful, you are committing to rehearsing three times a week until the show opens on the 3rd of July and the two weeks of performances. It is the responsibility of the cast member to ensure that they negotiate work and other personal commitments in order to attend all rehearsals and performances.

ABOUT THE SHOW

Based on the popular book by Lewis Carroll, *Alice in Wonderland* is a thrilling pantomime full of non-stop energy and excitement.

Alice is a young, naive girl who seeks more from her life than boring people and tedious lessons. One day, while listening to another lesson from her sister, Alice notices a white rabbit in a little vest run past and into a nearby rabbit hole. Alice is stricken with curiosity and decides to follow him down. What follows is an adventure that must been seen to be believed!

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

The creative team is looking for actors that are over the age of 12. As is pantomime tradition, gender is not a restriction when it comes to casting, anyone can audition for any role.

Alice (14+)

Strong vocalist with intermediate dance ability

Sweet and naive, our curious protagonist is thrown into a crazy world where she has very little time to figure out what is going on. Must have a likeable personality to connect with the audience.

Mad Hatter (17+)

Intermediate vocalist and dancer

Crazy, insane and highly unpredictable, every moment with him is fast and intense. Must be able to have high energy on the stage and lead scenes with entertaining personality.

Queen of Hearts (18+)

Strong vocalist with basic dance ability

With a massive ego and a temper to match, she is the show's antagonist. Must be able to deal with audience interaction and have a controlling presence. Preferred dame.

White Rabbit (14+)

Intermediate vocalist with basic dance ability

Constantly obsessed with time and always fretting over every single detail, he doesn't have time to slow down otherwise things will never get done. Must be able to portray a fast character in both movement and dialogue.

Cheshire Cat (14+)

Strong vocalist with basic dance ability

Very cunning with a mischievous streak, he takes enjoyment from teasing around and is the main audience connection. Must be comfortable with direct audience interaction and be able to connect with them.

The White Queen (15+)

Strong vocalist with basic dance ability

Extremely nice and soft-spoken, she is the sister to the Queen of Hearts and later becomes a mentor to Alice. Must be able to play a nice character who has a trusting personality.

Tweedledee & Tweedledum (14+)

Basic vocals and dance ability

These two are inseparable and nearly identical, always bouncing around and constantly interacting with each other. Must be able to work as a pair.

March Hare (14+)

Intermediate vocalist with basic dance ability Best pal of the Mad Hatter, he matches wits and is just as crazy. Will join the ensemble when not needed.

Caterpillar (14+)

Basic vocals and dance ability A questioning character with a contradictory nature. Will join the ensemble when not needed.

King of Hearts (14+)

Basic vocals and dance ability The pushover husband to the Queen of Hearts. Will join the ensemble when not needed.

The ensemble will play the rest of the popular characters from the book such as the playing cards or the talking flowers. Must have a strong dance ability and preferred strong vocals.


