



We then put the focus on our **Spotlight on Youth** as the classes perform their end of year productions. All shows are listed elsewhere in the Spotlighter.



Some Youth Theatre teachers attended workshops in New York this year, bringing back wonderful ideas and experience to pass on to our students.


Spotlight Youth Theatre is always looking at ways to improve and I am sure many students will benefit from the extra knowledge.





HIGH & HIGHER REVIVAL – The Mowtown Musical Congratulations Jamie Watt and his creative team, cast and crew!

Reviewed by Roger McKenzie (STAGE WHISPERS) Spotlight Theatre has revived a popular "juke box" musical from 2016 with great success.

It is a musical tribute to Motown during that great period in the 60's and 70's, featuring over 50 tunes. The pace is fast and furious with the six dancers hardly off stage and whipping up a nonstop whirlwind of energy.

Under the baton of Ben Murray, the four featured artists: Caroline Taylor, Jacquelyn Turner, Hannah Rigby and Jamie Watt were greatly supported by the seven piece onstage band and the four backup singers, who each had the opportunity to share their talents with the audience.

The simple staging was effective (I've never seen so many mirror balls of varying sizes dress a stage). The costumes and wigs added to the atmosphere along with Leonnie Jones' lighting.

The appreciative audience loved everything about the performance.


