

All Individual ticket holders' details have to be recorded for contact tracing.

All positions are vacated and if you would like to be part of the Management Committee, nomination forms are available in this edition or at Costume Hire.

Joel Beskin has accepted the position of Returning Officer for this election and all nominations have to be received by the Returning Officer at least 24 Hours before the meeting.







The Junior Drama students have just started rehearsing for their play and auditions were held last week.

Intermediate classes have had their scripts for "Alice In Wonderland" for a while now and I sat in on some of the rehearsals this week. The students' enthusiasm is really good to watch and I have attached a couple of photos for you to see the classes in action.

Sadly we have lost some students, because of COVID-19, however, we have welcomed nine new students into our

Shirley is the Editor of the Spotlighter and doesn't have a lot to do with the Youth Theatre directly. Anything you send to her, has to be redirected to me. Kay is also working for the Youth Theatre as the accountant and is always there for me. We are all volunteers and if the enquiries come straight to me it saves so much time and I try to answer everything almost immediately.

There is little doubt that we will be sending out more notices than we usually do this term, everything will be a little different but we are so excited to be back operating classes again. Please make sure you open your emails often, and reply to the correct source.

Hannah, Matt and Shelley will be auditioning and working towards their productions this term. These teachers are quite amazing I think from now on they will be living at the theatre. Schedules will be tight and it would be appreciated if you can make sure your student is on time for class and rehearsals.



Spotlight on Environment

We are taking part in the Cash for Containers Scheme to help the environment and also get some valuable funds for the theatre. Since we joined we have earned over \$1,000 by recycling the cans, bottles and plastic bottles at the local depot. We have our own Scheme ID number C10106788.

How can you help?

Every day you will be using containers that have a 10c refund on them. When you have finished with them instead of throwing them in your waste to end up in landfill why not recycle them and help us.

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will help your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

What can you recycle that is refundable?

All beer and pre mix spirit cans and bottles.

All soft drink cans and bottles.

All plastic drink bottles, water and soft drinks.

No wine bottles please as these are not part of refund scheme.

(They are recyclable so put them in your yellow top bin.)

We will be doing more environmental friendly changes to help lower the amount of landfill in 2020, so please help us to help you to help the environment.




