


Clem and Shelly are lucky enough to know and love 'Mr Boyd' ... Michael is Shelly's nephew.

### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

### WE ARE READY TO WELCOME YOU BACK

We are still on track to re-open the Halpin Auditorium on Friday 31 July. We have developed a Covid - 19 Safe Plan to be submitted to Queensland Health for approval and Stage 3 is reached.

Our focus has been to make it as safe as possible for all staff, cast, crew, volunteers, and patrons.

Stage 2 of the Queensland Government's easing of restriction has allowed more cast and crew into the theatre to rehearse. Prior to anyone being allowed to enter the theatre they had to attend an information session, and understand and agree to adhere to the procedures put in place.

I cannot list all the changes here that we have made, to make your visit to the theatre as safe as possible, but it will be different. We will require all patrons to adhere to social distancing and signs will be reminding patrons. I ask all of you to follow the instructions of the Volunteers who are there to help you be safe. Some of the changes are that there will be one way in and one way out. The two car parking spaces beside the theatre will be blocked off prior to a show night. The disability Car space will be moved to in front of Costume Hire. The auditorium will open at 6-30 pm and you will be asked to take your seats as soon as you arrive. You will be required to use the touch free sanitizer unit placed in the Foyer. Table service will be provided so that you can still enjoy a drink. Interval will be extended so that there will be plenty of time to visit the Bathroom. At the end of the show we will provide table service so that you don't have to all leave together.

Tickets are on sale **NOW** but they will **NOT** be available to be purchased on line and must be ordered by calling the Ticket Office on **5539 4255** or in Person. The Capacity is restricted so there are fewer tickets available. The Ticket Office is located in Costume Hire and opening hours are 10 -30am to 4-30pm Monday to Friday and 9am to 3pm Saturday. All Individual Ticket Holders' details have to be recorded for contact tracing.

Volunteer's training/information session is currently scheduled for **Sunday 26 July.** Leeanne and Ross will contact you all, via email, to confirm date and time. This will be the only session so it is imperative that you attend so that we can include you on the roster.

**Costume Hire** is NOW open but with strict number of patrons allowed in the store at any one time. Telephone orders can still be made. All preventative measures have been implemented to keep everyone safe. The staff has worked really hard whilst in Lockdown and has made many changes to the shop. They are currently having a sale on Merchandise to welcome you back. They would Love to see you.

**Youth Theatre** is on track to resume in Term 3 and information sessions have been arranged for all students and parents to attend prior to their return to the Theatre complex.

The rehearsals of Bodyguard are looking fantastic and I thank **Directors Clem and Shelly Halpin** and their amazing Cast and Crew for their commitment, in these challenging times, to make sure that you will see an outstanding show.




What a great morning at auditions for *The Psychic* in our Basement Theatre!!


