### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The ticket office was kept busy as *Footloose*, directed by former Youth Theatre student and current Young Adults student **Nathan French**, sold out before it even opened on 23 October in the Halpin Auditorium and three extra performances were added to the season. Congratulations to everyone involved. This high energy show has the audience's toe tapping and singing along.

November through to Mid December sees our Youth Theatre take over the Halpin Auditorium so that each class can perform their end of year productions and parents and grandparents can see how their children have progressed.

With the restrictions imposed on numbers we only have limited seating available and COVID regulations have been a challenge for the Youth Theatre administration and staff to accommodate patrons, making sure that we still abide by distancing regulations.

Costume Hire was really busy for Halloween and continues to expand its range of costumes and merchandise so if you haven't been in for a while come and have a look at the changes that have been made.

Our *Annual Spotlight on Christmas* this year will be combined with our *65<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebrations* on **18 and 19 December. Tickets are on sale now at \$25 with no Concessions.** Be quick as restrictions still apply.

**Hansel & Gretel** directed by **Ryan Bourke** is well into rehearsal and will be the first show in 2021 and the first pantomime to be performed in the Halpin Auditorium. Tickets are not yet on sale for this production.

Our first major production of the year **Jersey Boys**, directed by award winning director **Cilla Scott**, has held auditions and the fabulous cast selected will be announced soon.

We have managed to secure another grant from the Queensland Government to help recover from this very difficult year. We received \$8310 to pay for some repairs to the theatre. We are also pleased to announce that **KDV Sports** are proudly supporting our Youth Theatre and our Bar, called **The Spot**, is now proudly sponsored by **SEWROO Products**. Thank you to both companies for your support.

So that we can afford to replace the carpet in the Halpin Auditorium we have re-introduced running a raffle at each performance however in a slightly different way. To make everything as contactless as possible we now have a board with one hundred numbers and you can purchase three numbers for \$5 and once all numbers are sold we have a roulette wheel on a mobile phone that randomly selects the lucky number for the night. Please support our raffle so that we can continue to upgrade the theatre and keep afloat.

We also participate in the Containers for Change scheme to help the environment and get some extra cash for the company, so please support us by bringing any refundable containers to us. I thank Graham and Leanne Schulz for taking all the containers to the depot when our bins are full.

It has certainly been a challenging few months and without your support and the wonderful volunteers it would not have been possible, so I thank each and every one of you for your support, efforts and commitment and bringing back the Spotlight Family feel to Team Spotlight.

# **Spotlight on Environment**

We are taking part in the Cash for Containers Scheme to help the environment and also get some valuable funds for the theatre. Since we joined we have earned over \$1,000 by recycling the cans, bottles and plastic bottles at the local depot. We have our own Scheme ID number C10106788.

### How can you help?

Every day you will be using containers that have a 10c refund on them. When you have finished with them instead of throwing them in your waste to end up in landfill why not recycle them and help us.

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will help your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

### What can you recycle that is refundable?

All beer and pre mix spirit cans and bottles.

All soft drink cans and bottles.

All plastic drink bottles, water and soft drinks.

No wine bottles please as these are not part or refund scheme.

(They are recyclable so put them in your yellow top bin.)

We will be doing more environmental friendly changes to help lower the amount of landfill in 2020, so please help us to help you to help the environment.

If anyone has any doubts about times etc., please do not hesitate to contact me and I will try to sort out any problems.


Towards the end of the year I will send out 2021 enrolment forms. Some students will move up and the teachers will advise these students.






