


It's that time of year again, where the theatre becomes alive and abuzz with 8 Youth Theatre productions spearheading the end of year playbill!




I am really looking forward to catching up with all parents in October/November/December. Best wishes.

This was the first play performed in the Halpin Auditorium and was an outstanding success with two extra performances added to meet the demand for tickets. Helen put together a stellar cast and crew and created an amazing set highlighting her eye for detail.

Thank you to all who were involved to bring this show to the Spotlight Stage. You were a credit to your profession and a pleasure to watch. *Congratulations and Well Done!*

Footloose The Musical directed by former Youth Theatre student and current Young Adults student **Nathan French** opens in the Halpin Auditorium on 23 October through to 14 November.

Interest and ticket sales for this show have been extraordinary so if you haven't got your ticket phone the Ticket Office on **5539 4255** NOW to secure a seat. **PLEASE NOTE** that conditions of entry and procedures have changed so please arrive early so that you can be seated and table service provided.

Tickets are on sale and must be ordered by calling the Ticket Office on **5539 4255** or in person. The capacity is restricted, so there are fewer tickets available and **STRICT** conditions apply. The Ticket Office is located in Costume Hire and opening hours are 10.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and 9am to 3pm Saturday. All Individual Ticket holders' details have to be recorded for contact tracing.

This year we celebrate **our 65th Birthday** and due to time and space restraints we are combining our Birthday celebrations with our **Annual Spotlight on Christmas on 18 and 19 December.** This year there will be a live band and invited guest singers highlighting previous shows as well as singing some well-known carols. At this stage, unless the regulations and restrictions are lifted, there will be limited seats available so keep your eye out for when the tickets go on sale.

We have just received confirmation that the Company has been successful in obtaining a grant from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund of \$31,000 to upgrade our sound system. We hope to have this upgrade in place at the beginning of 2021.

Our Youth Theatre students have all their end of year productions coming up so the teachers and students are excitedly preparing to perform on the larger stage. Due to the limit on seating imposed for these shows, ticket numbers are being allocated to each student.

I would also like to thank all the wonderful volunteers who have embraced the changes imposed on the theatre and without their commitment to Spotlight we could not put on these shows. Thank you to each and every one of you for your outstanding work and effort and becoming part of **TEAM SPOTLIGHT**.

TOGETHER we are getting through the challenges set for us during this extraordinary year and I thank everybody for their co-operation, understanding and support as we continue to strive to make sure that **Spotlight Theatre is a safe place for all to visit and to provide outstanding service and shows.**

Recently, he was promoted to the role of Assistant Cruise Director for the Oceania cruise ships and continues to pursue his passion for performing all over the world.



Spotlight on Environment

We are taking part in the **Cash for Containers Scheme** to help the environment and also get some valuable funds for the theatre. Since we joined we have earned over \$1,000 by recycling the cans, bottles and plastic bottles at the local depot. We have our own **Scheme ID number C10106788**.

How can you help?

Every day you will be using containers that have a 10c refund on them. When you have finished with them instead of throwing them in your waste to end up in landfill why not recycle them and help us.

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will help your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

What can you recycle that is refundable? All beer and pre mix spirit cans and bottles. All soft drink cans and bottles. All plastic drink bottles, water and soft drinks.

No wine bottles please as these are not part or refund scheme.

(They are recyclable so put them in your yellow top bin.)

We will be doing more environmental friendly changes to help lower the amount of landfill in 2020, so please help us to help you to help the environment.
