MATT PEARSON: A long time Spotlight Theatre Music Director, Matt has worked on numerous productions in varying roles since 2005. He started as a musician for HOTA (formerly The Gold Coast Arts Centre) productions of **ANNIE**, **HAIR**, **BROADWAY IN CONCERT**, **ALL SHOOK UP & THE BOY FROM OZ**, before making the move to Spotlight Theatre in 2008.

In 2010, Matt was the Conductor for the Australian Premiere of *CURTAINS: THE MUSICAL COMEDY WHODUNNIT*, and in 2013 was Associate Music Director & Conductor on the

Queensland Amateur Premiere of *THE PHANTOM OF THE OPERA*. In 2012, Matt won the inaugural "Best Vocal Director" award at the Gold Coast Theatre Awards for his work on Spotlight's *HAIRSPRAY*, and again won this award in 2014 for his work on Spotlight's *SWEENEY TODD: THE DEMON BARBER OF FLEET STREET*.

As Music Director, Matt consistently worked on critically acclaimed productions including 2015's new production of *THE BOY FROM OZ*, 2017's Gold Coast revival of *LES MISERABLES*, and 2018's concert oratorio production of Monty Python's *HE'S NOT THE MESSIAH*, *HE'S A VERY NAUGHTY BOY* featuring a 35 piece orchestra (including live Bagpipes) and a 30 piece choir.

In 2017, Matt was not only Music Director, but also Vocal Arranger and Orchestrater for Spotlight's production of **BOYBAND: THE MUSICAL**.


Since 2014, Matt has been the Music Director for Spotlight Youth Theatre, and since then has seen a number of his students go on to study and graduate from the Queensland Conservatorium, VCA, WAAPA, and NIDA, and are now continually working professionally in the field.



HANNAH CROWTHER made her professional theatre debut in *OKLAHOMA!* and then as Rumpleteazer in *CATS* for Harvest Rain Theatre Company. In 2017 Hannah choreographed *THE PRODUCERS* for Savoyards Musical Society and in 2013 she earned a Gold Coast Theatre Award for choreographing the original musical *BILLY BUCKETT* (Beenleigh Theatre Company).

For the **24Hour Musical Project** she worked as Dance Captain in 2016 and then as Assistant Choreographer and Dance Captain in 2017.

Hannah toured Australia with Camp Quality as part of their education program, anti-bullying puppet shows *INSIDE OUT* and *THE WAY YOU LOOK AT IT*, has also performed internationally with The Hong Kong Oratorio Society and toured to California Adventureland, Knotts Berry Farm and Disneyland. She also performs weekly as vocal partner, vocal arranger and dance director with DJR PRODUCTIONS. Throughout her life, Hannah has completed various dance, drama and musical theatre exams, most notably having achieved a Diploma in Musical Theatre with Distinction (Trinity College of London), Grade 1 Theatrical Examination (Commonwealth Society of Teachers of Dancing), and Intermediate Ballet (Royal Academy of Dancing).



Wait Until Dark (2018), Joe Pendleton in Heaven Can Wait (2018), Dan Kelly in KELLY (2019), Jake in NAPAs Be More Chill (2020), Jersey Boys (2021) and recently directed his first musical Firebringer at Spotlight Theatre (2020). During the day he works at Sea World, Paradise Country and Movie World in Show & Entertainment, performing and presenting shows and presentations. He is incredibly excited and humbled to be a part of Spotlight Theatrical Company's team of Teachers for 2021. He specialises in deep character work and exploration, utilising Uta Hagens acting techniques and voice & speech.



KORI RICHARDS: Born in London and being passionate about acting and performance, thrived on working and auditioning for film and television shows. She was lucky enough to work on *Harry Potter, James Bond, The Mummy* and many other Block Buster films.

She enjoys sharing her passion with other people and developing skills that are transferable across the arts.



SHANNON HATCHMAN: From the age of 3 Shannon began her dancing career attending jazz, ballet and tap classes out of a tiny studio in a small country town just outside of the Sunshine Coast.

As a dedicated dancer her talents shone through at a young age, winning QLD state level ATOD (Australian Teachers of Dancing) scholarships, after completing her full ATOD exams in Ballet, Jazz and Tap. Shannon then continued on with her talents as an overall performer after winning "The David Atkins award" at the ATOD & #39's

Australasian scholarships, with a musical theatre number in 2010. Also, during this time Shannon attended part-time at ADPI (Australia & #39's Dancing and Performing Arts) in Brisbane studying part-time Musical Theatre. Shannon was selected as the only soloist and feature artist to perform at the Queensland & #39's Schools on Stage Spectacular *Creative Generation* in 2010. She has also danced with Velocity, Raw and Harvest Rain Theatre Company during this time.

In 2011 Shannon commenced her two-year full-time studies at Sydney's prestigious Ed5 International Performing Arts School, graduating in 2012 with her Diploma in Performing Arts. Since graduating Shannon has worked with many performers and artist's throughout Sydney. Some of these include Guy Sebastian, Samantha Jade (Sydney Mardi Gras), William Forysthe, Loredo Malcolm, Sam Moran (Yellow Wiggle) and American choreographer's Michael Schwandt and Galen Hooks. In early 2016 she made her musical theatre debut in the Australian production of *Bring It On, The Musical*, as a featured ensemble member. Shortly after that she was off to Macau to perform at James Packer's prestigious venue, Studio City in the show *House of Magic* to fulfil her 6 month overseas contract. In October 2018 she debuted her career as a choreographer in the production of *Rock of Ages-The Musical* Sydney, which received promising reviews and praise for her massive efforts she put into the show. Most recently Shannon was the production assistant, stage manager, choreographer, dance and creative team assistant for the production *Creative Generation* 2019 and 2020.

Late 2019 she completed her AUS National tour with *The World of Magic,* performing as a dancer and magicians assistant, alongside Australia's prestigious Illusionist, Michael Boyd. Shan loves to educate, inspire, influence and continue sharing the love and passion she has for performing, to all that put their heart and soul into their craft.



JORDAN BOYD: Jordan is a passionate actress, drama teacher, and stage manager, who has been surrounded by the arts and entertainment industry for as long as she can remember. She began her journey through the industry at 9 years old, dancing competitively for 5 years, before diving into the dramatic arts. She studied Music Theatre and Drama through high school, and eventually graduated from Griffith University in 2018 with a Bachelor of Arts in Contemporary and Applied Theatre. In that same year, she was offered a place with Jack Moreton Worldwide as a Stage

Management Intern and worked on the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games opening and closing ceremonies. Her theatre credits include *Our Town* (Griffith University), *Disney's The Little Mermaid* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), *Avenue Q* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), *The Pillowman* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), *Ladies In Black* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), *Spamalot* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), and *Jersey Boys* (Spotlight Theatre). Jordan has a keen love of working with young performers, nourishing their love for the arts, and has spent most of her stage management career working with large children's casts.



JANE GRIMLEY: Jane is an independent theatre director and performing artist. Jane's most recent work *The World's Best Worst House Party* received the prize for best immersive work and a national touring award at Sydney Fringe Festival 2019. Jane is an accomplished teaching artist specialising in the development of young and emerging artists. How can you help?

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.



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SYNOPSIS: **Beautiful** tells the true story of Carole King's meteoric rise to fame as one of the twentieth century's foremost singer-songwriters. We are introduced to Carole when she is 16 and pitching her first song ("It Might As Well Rain Until September") to New York music producer Don Kirshner. Soon after, she meets her future husband and creative collaborator, Gerry Goffin. In a musical whirlwind, the couple are married, King gives birth to their first child and the duo make a name for themselves in the music business, knocking out hit after hit. However, while their careers are on the rise, Carole's personal life falls apart when Gerry announces that he wants an affair. As Carole tries to negotiate marriage, adultery and personal happiness, she is supported by friends and playful rivals, Cynthia Weil and Barry Mann. Although they all compete for number one hits on the pop chart, Carole relies on their support to change her life and find her own voice. Set in the vibrant pop industry of the 1960s and early 1970s, Beautiful: The Carole King Musical features a tapestry of musical hits from the creative songwriting teams of King and Goffin, Weil and Mann.

Since then she has gone on to direct and choreograph the Queensland premiere production of *Be More Chill* and most recently *Downtown: The Mod Musical*.


He also created his own solo main stage show of jazz hits entitled "The Music Of Me" which has now been showcased on three vessels, travelling all over the world.


We have a new member Monique, who is fitting in well with our group and looking forward to singing and dancing with us.
