

With all the restrictions imposed due to Covid, the growth of the youth theatre numbers and the need to make some changes in the Basement, we have secured a new venue in Johnston Street Southport. From Term 3 all youth theatre classes will be held in the studios. This will also allow us the time and space to do some internal changes to the Basement Theatre so that we can reopen it to the general public in the new year with our January Pantomime. We will also be holding Auditions and Rehearsals in these studios as well.

Thank you to Jenny, Michelle, Helen, Kirsty, Leeanne and Lorrae for all their efforts and work at The Costume Hire Car Park Sale. With their efforts we managed to clear a lot of excess stock. *Well done ladies!*

We are still collecting the bottles and cans as part of the **Cash for Containers program** but have had to move the bins and place locks on them as last week someone took all the stock we had collected before we could get it to the depot. It is very sad that people wish to steal from us as a charity.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Lastly remember that it is legislated and mandated by the Queensland State Government that all Hospitality venues must make all patrons who visit, sign in using the Check in QLD app. We have to refuse entry to anyone that doesn't sign in, **even if you have a ticket,** so, if you haven't done it yet, **download the app now** <u>https://www.covid19.qld.gov.au/check-in-qld</u>. It is so easy and once you have the app on your phone you use it at all venues you visit. The State Government can close us down if we do not comply to this legislation so **please do it now** and you will be ready when you visit us next.

August is the month of the AGM which is being held on **Tuesday 17 August** so put that date in your calendar so that you can hear how all departments have fared in this financial year and vote for your next Management Committee members, as all positions are vacated.

That's about it from me so until next month look after yourselves and each other.

Spotlight on Environment

We are taking part in the **Cash for Containers Scheme** to help the environment and also get some valuable funds for the theatre. Since we joined we have earned almost \$2000 by recycling the cans, bottles and plastic bottles at the local depot. We have our own **Scheme ID number C10106788**.

How can you help?

Every day you will be using containers that have a 10c refund on them. When you have finished with them instead of throwing them in your waste to end up in landfill why not recycle them and help us.

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will help your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

> What can you recycle that is refundable? All beer and pre mix spirit cans and bottles. All soft drink cans and bottles. All plastic drink bottles, water and soft drinks. WE ALSO GET 10 CENTS ON THOSE LITTLE YAKULT BOTTLES



No wine bottles please as these are not part of the refund scheme.

(They are recyclable so put them in your yellow top bin.)

We will be doing more environmental friendly changes to help lower the amount of landfill in 2021, so please help us to help you to help the environment.

CONGRATULATIONS Nick and Shari and a huge welcome to baby, Archer.






