

YOUTH THEATRE ADMINISTRATION REPORT

All of our shows are finished for 2021, the final one being *Urinetown* performed by our Senior Students. It was an amazing performance. I went to see it with mixed feelings as I had never seen the show, although I did know it was in London for quite a while. I came out of the theatre so excited, it was such a good show. Well done to all of the students and teachers and of course Hannah and Matt; what a great team of teachers you are.

With all of the programmes over for 2021 I would like to thank all of the parents for being so patient when I send an email at the last minute because of a change in schedules and for getting your students to the studio/theatre on time; it certainly has been a challenging year.

All parents should have received the 2022 enrolment form in the last week. It is necessary for you to complete this form together with the "all risk" form which was attached, as this form has to be sent in each year, it is a regulation.

You will see from the 2022 enrolment form that we have changed the classes around significantly. We have tried to spread the classes over a couple of nights in the hope that it may help with school commitments. You will also notice that we are no longer going by age to determine the students position in the class, it will be in accordance with the school grade that student is in.

We have also added a Song and Dance class to our Junior Drama programme. Students can now do the Drama programme and song and dance. The two classes go together, so parents can choose the 1.30 Drama class followed by Song and Dance or the Song and Dance followed by the 3.30 Drama class.

We will hold our classes open for current students only until the 3rd January, after which time we will offer them to students who are waiting to join Spotlight. Our classes this year are restricted to just 20 students per class.





You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will bein your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

> What can-you recycle that is refundable? All beer and pre mix spirit cans and bottles. All soft drink cans and bottles. All plastic drink bottles, water and soft drinks.

No wine bottles please as these are not part of the refund scheme.

(They are recyclable so put them in your yellow top bin.)

We will be doing more environmental friendly changes to help lower the amount of landfill in 2021, so please help us to help you to help the environment.
