

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#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The New year has started off at a cracking pace with *Chicago*, directed by the multi award winner **Cilla Scott** in its final rehearsal weeks before opening on 17 February in the Halpin Auditorium. The set is nearly completely installed, painted and ready. There has been such a demand for tickets that we have managed to add some extra performances so if you haven't booked yet check the website and see what tickets may be available.

In the Basement Theatre rehearsals are underway for our first play of the year **EXIT** directed by the one and only Clem Halpin an icon of the industry. The set is still under construction. This play written by James Hall, a local writer, has its world Premiere at Spotlight Theatre when it opens on 14 April. Tickets go on sale to members on Wednesday 1 February.



In our Johnston Street Studios auditions have been held for our second Musical of the Year *Gypsy* directed by David Valks. The cast for this classic show will be announced soon.

Our Johnston Street Studios have also been spruced up a bit for the start of the Youth Theatre classes for 2023. There is still some work to do at the studios which we hope to have completed by the end of next month.

We have also had the Basement dressing room completely re painted and new air-conditioner installed to make it just a little more comfortable for the actors.

**Costume Hire** held its **Car Park Sale** on 21 January, and this was such a success that we are planning on holding another one midyear. More details once a date has been selected.

**HANNAH CROWTHER** – Hannah's passion for theatre started early; from acrobatics, pantomimes, all types of dance, singing in choirs, and eventually finding Musical Theatre, it was clear she was at home on a stage. Almost as soon as she could, she started teaching anybody who would learn and eventually made a career as a choreographer and musical theatre teacher. The first show Hannah choreographed, original musical BILLY BUCKETT, earned her a Gold Palm Theatre Award in 2013. Since then, she hasn't stopped working and teaching across Brisbane and the Gold Coast. Teaching for The Spotlight Theatrical Company, Hannah directed and choreographed numerous Youth musicals including **42nd Street**, **Urinetown** and **Legally Blonde**. **All Shook Up** and **13!** were nominated for **Best Director**, **Best** 

Choreography, Best Youth Production and Outstanding Production in 2020. After many years teaching, 2021 brought Hannah back to the stage in productions of *Puffs, Beautiful, Bring It Back* and *Jersey Boys* (best supporting actress nomination Gold Palm Theatre Award). Hannah toured Australia with Camp Quality as part of their education program, anti-bullying puppet shows *Inside Out* and *The Way You Look At It*. She currently works at The Starlight Children's Foundation entertaining sick children at the Queensland Children's Hospital. Her notable qualifications for dance, drama and musical theatre include: Diploma in Musical Theatre with Distinction (Trinity College of London), Grade 1 Theatrical Examination (Commonwealth Society of Teachers of Dancing), and Intermediate Ballet (Royal Academy of Dancing).

**MELISSA DORGE** – After attaining her **Bachelor's degree (Drama) from QUT and her ATCL Diploma in Speech and Drama, (Teaching)** Melissa has been fortunate enough to have worked at a number of schools on the Gold Coast and Northern NSW, teaching Speech and Drama and Musical Theatre (Acting/Singing) for the past 14 years.

An enthusiastic performer herself, Melissa has been a part of many productions at Spotlight Theatrical Company over the past decades. The last few years, Melissa has taken a step back from being onstage, to focus more on directing and writing. She has had several plays entered in the Gold Coast Secondary School Dramafest competition, with great success throughout the years.



Melissa's passion and experience in Musical Theatre is something she is excited to be able to share with students, along with her love of acting and learning the art of telling stories through character, song and dance.

Ethan directed various scenes throughout the classes and thoroughly enjoyed it. Seeing as that was a new role under his belt, he was given the opportunity to become a scriptwriter and co-wrote one of the short plays seen in last year's drama festival. With Co-Director and Co-Writer under his belt, Ethan was given another chance to prove himself, with putting on the Drama Festival with his other drama teachers Mel and Liam. He is eternally grateful for all they did with helping him prepare the students. Ethan is also currently studying a bachelor of education at **Griffith University**,

with hopes of being a high school drama teacher. This year Ethan is very excited to be **Head Drama Teacher** for **Spotlight Youth Theatre**. In the span of a year Ethan has seen what these students are capable of and is extremely excited to ignite the spark that resides within all students at Spotlight. He is excited as well to work with his fabulous team of teachers and is ready to give back to the company that inspired him when he did Youth theatre.

**CATHERINE LEWIS** – Catherine is a **Film and Theatre trained Actor** based on the Gold Coast Queensland. She began her professional training in 2002 at **Griffith University** completing her **Bachelor of Applied Theatre Degree** in 2007 in the top five percent.

Within the Bachelor degree Catherine was gifted an international transfer for six months at **Guelph University in Ontario Canada**. She continued her studies at **Sixteentth Film and Television Actors' Studio** as a full time course in Melbourne, graduating in 2012. The alumni consisted of Kerry Armstrong, Noni Hazelhurst, and Directors Alkinos Tsilimidos, and Kim Farrant 'Strangerland'. Catherine continued to work in various advanced drop in classes inclusive of Vocal, Movement and Scene work with Ms Armstrong.



Catherine was selected as one of 30 participants in the Larry Moss Masterclass three years in a row and built a great professional relationship with L.A based Mr Moss (acting coach to Hilary Swank, Leonardo DiCaprio, and Jim Carey). Catherine was then selected to participate in the Elisbeth Kemp masterclass, Teacher at The American Academy of Dramatic Arts in New York, and acting coach to Bradley Cooper.

Catherine then moved to Sydney and worked on an array of short films and theatre productions and began teaching at **Marian Street Theatre For Young People.** Alongside taking multiple classes inclusive of scene work and self devised improvisations, Catherine designed a program for 8-13 year old access needs students. She designed the program around each individual's needs, hoping together each child felt, free, inspired and had a lot of fun with various games, improvisations and script work.

Miss Lewis moved back to the Gold Coast early last year and has been working on several productions and individual projects.



**GEORGIA BECK** – Georgia is an experienced musical theatre teacher, performer, and choreographer. After graduating from the **Youth Theatre Program** Georgia went on to secure her **Cert. III in Dance** and is completing her **Bachelor in Primary Education**. She has previous experience as a dance and vocal teacher at numerous Gold Coast dance schools and is excited to bring her knowledge back to the place she started. Her performance experience ranges from professional TV sets to local theatre productions. Georgia's recent credits include *Singin' in the Rain, The Bureau of Magical Things on Nickelodeon*, Ariel in *Footloose*, Scaramouche in *We Will Rock You* as well as other professional gigs across South East Queensland.

#### **SOPHIA** - Emily Rowbottom



# **Spotlight on Environment**

We are taking part in the **Cash for Containers Scheme** to help the environment and also get some valuable funds for the theatre. Since we joined we have earned almost **\$5,000** by recycling the cans, bottles and plastic bottles at the local depot. We have our own **Scheme ID number C10106788**.

#### How can you help?

Every day you will be using containers that have a 10c refund on them. When you have finished with them instead of throwing them in your waste to end up in landfill why not recycle them and help us.

You can take them to the local depot yourself and, instead of collecting the cash, put our scheme number above into the system and the funds will be directly deposited into our account.

Or you could drop them off at the theatre when you next visit and when we have collected a decent amount, a volunteer takes them to the recycling depot. It doesn't matter if you only have one or two or twenty or more, every one you give to us will help your theatre earn valuable coin to help meet the costs of running the complex.

#### CHANGED PARKING CONDITIONS AT BENOWA GARDENS SHOPPING CENTRE FOR SPOTLIGHT PATRONS AND VOLUNTEERS

The Management Committees of Spotlight Theatre and Benowa Gardens Shopping Centre have worked together to continue to provide parking at the Shopping Centre when you attend the Theatre.

#### **IMPORTANT UPDATE**

YOU MUST PARK IN THE UNDERGROUND CAR PARK. YOU MUST GET YOUR CAR REGISTRATION NUMBER VALIDATED FOR EXTENSION OF TIME LIMIT.

WHY: The Management of Benowa Gardens Shopping Centre have installed car registration number identification cameras at all entrances to their Car Park.

There is a free three hour time limit and a charge of \$80 for those that stay over the three hours.

HOW: Spotlight has been provided with a validation machine that extends the amount of time you can stay without charge.

PROCESS TO VALIDATE: Your car registration number is entered into the validation machine and takes about a minute to do.

What this means for you is that if you are having dinner at the Shopping Centre prior to attending the theatre you can ask most of the restaurants to validate your stay.

The theatre can also validate your stay if you are having dinner first and forget to get a validation. The volunteer staff at Spotlight can assist.

If you are just attending the theatre the staff can validate your stay if you feel you will be parked for longer than 3 hours. <u>Note:</u> Most night time shows finish around 10pm.

Please support the businesses at the Benowa Gardens Shopping Centre, as they have kindly supported Spotlight Theatre by allowing our Patrons to stay longer than the three (3) hour limit, provided that we park in the underground Carpark and we get our Car Registration Number Validated at the theatre.
