



ABOUT THE WRITER JAMES HALL



BURN is the second play from myself as playwright and Clem Halpin as director.

My first interest in writing bubbled back in 1997 when I watched "Good Will Hunting" at the movies. I was instantly amazed about how two young friends could pen such an emotional and entertaining piece. It piqued a curiosity that's never died down.

However, it wasn't until many years after this moment that the tingling inspiration to write a play surged out onto the page. I find something magical lives within the joy of sitting in front of the computer and darting down imagination's countless rabbit holes. Similarly, reading a script that can ultimately be called a final draft is a very special and satisfying moment.

I don't have formal training in writing - which director Clem Halpin says is blatantly obvious considering how left-field and confronting my works can be! More so, I've fallen in love with being able to momentarily morph into a crazed creator of different characters, emotions, truths, and sub-existences.

I was fortunate enough for my first play, EXIT, to be a success, and I have the absolute honour of my second play, BURN, being performed in Spotlight's Basement Theatre from April 12th to 27th. (PS. I'm currently completing a third script – this time a comedy, a purposeful contrast to my first two psychological drama plays – and am hopeful there might be a hattrick of Spotlight productions

ABOUT THE PLAY


BURN is a psychological drama that dissects the dynamic between two polar opposite brothers. It includes elements of trademark darkness, as well as other emotional touchstones, namely, the underlying turns the five characters force upon each other to manipulate circumstances to their own advantage. Audiences will be attracted to each character's arc and, with a devastating twist at the end of the script, they'll appreciate the tragic foundations of the story they've just witnessed. Clem and I have found there is a distinct thirst for local, original dramatic plays, as highlighted by the universally passionate response to EXIT. 
