

CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

Cast: 6F, 1M

QUINN: 30 – 38	Single, going nowhere
CONNIE: 28 – 38	Engaged, Quinn's best friend
RACHEL: 30 – 40	Friend, married, new mum
ALEX: 35 – 50	Friend, divorced, uni student
MEADOW: 55 – 65	Quinn's mum, divorced
LYNN: 55 – 65	Connie's mum, widowed
TAJ: 30 – 40	Nice guy, single, Quinn's boss

QUINN: This is the featured character and is a large role: Sharp witted and cutting. Says it like it is. She's smart but just can't see anything through. Her 3-year uni degree stretched out to 7. Flawed? Absolutely, but she's no stranger to her own reflection. She knows every scar, every missed opportunity but wears them like battle scars, a testament to her authenticity. Quinn's not everyone's cup of Chamomile tea, but she's fiercely loyal to those who see past the surface – a friend who'll dissect your problems with surgical precision. She strives to find her purpose, if she could just get out of her own way.

CONNIE: For Connie, life is a balance between practicality and heartstrings. The girl next door. A+ Student. Engaged, however everyone but Connie can see her fiancé is not the right fit. Quinn and Connie are an odd a pair but somehow their differences compliment each other. They've been besties since high school. Con has no issue telling Quinn when she's gone too far, which happens often. And just maybe, Quinn's wild heart holds the answer Connie's been searching for all along.

RACHEL: Rachel's life is a delicate dance between secrets and survival. Her marriage to a controlling husband is a suffocating waltz, each step carefully measured. Her friends see a polished façade. They don't know about her bruised heart. She's too embarrassed, too ashamed to tell them. Every now and then, she takes a swig of an alcoholic drink to calm her nerves. Not an alcoholic, just a coping mechanism. Rach met Quinn working at a nightclub and clicked.

ALEX: is a vibrant and resilient woman. Single and doing life well. Navigating the next phase of life. Mature aged student who decided to study Psychology – a choice that emerged from the rubble of two failed marriages. Armed with her newfound knowledge, she enthusiastically experiments on her friends with her new vocabulary without finesse, but always with wide eyed enthusiasm. Alex grows in confidence and skill throughout the play. She was the head receptionist at the same nightclub where Rachel and Quinn once worked.

MEADOW: Real name, 'Melony' Brooke, but changed it when she discovered life shouldn't be taken too seriously, burnt her bras and let her hair grow – (in all places). Meadow was married to a decent man, - Quinn's Dad, who was just a bit too straight for her once she morphed into a tree hugging, kaftan wearing, earth mother. Meadow actually barracks for Quinn, so beneath her teasing and scepticism, she yearns to see her daughter succeed.

LYNN: Connie's Mum is the epitome of warmth and motherly love without being sappy. She's well-spoken, a testament to her refined upbringing, but don't mistake her elegance for fragility; Lynn has a backbone of steel. Loves to travel. Has hard-earned money but wealth has only fuelled her wanderlust. Has come back from a wonderful cruise to find out she's sick, but remains in denial determined to keep her sails set towards brighter shores. As she clings to dear life, her love for Connie is unwavering.

TAJ: Taj embodies kindness and empathy. He could be gay, but we're not sure. He's a smart dresser, casual but not sloppy. He's grounded and steady, playing a crucial role in helping Quinn to find her purpose. He could be an aged care nurse and patients would adore him. His purpose in life is to lift people out of their blues. He's very likeable.
